

Sixth Form Uniform

FEMALE DRESS CODE:

- Smart business suit with matching trousers, skirt or dress (must be dark)
- Skirts must be at least knee length (mini, lycra or body con skirts are not permitted)
- Blouse or shirt (plain or subtly patterned which must be tucked in or fitted)
- Formal shoes or boots (must be able to polish them)
- Jewellery and make-up are permitted but should not be excessive
- Plain V-neck jumper or cardigan (must be dark)

MALE DRESS CODE:

- Smart trouser suit (must be dark)
- Formal shirt (plain or subtly patterned which must be tucked in)
- Suitable business-like tie
- Formal shoes or Boots (must be able to polish them)
- Plain V-neck jumper (Must be dark)



BOTH: coats and scarves may be worn outside the buildings but must be removed once inside.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT PERMITTED:



- Denim – Jeans (any style), trousers/skirts and jackets
- Casual trousers – combats, tracksuits, leggings
- Casual tops – tracksuit, fleeces, T-shirts, hooded tops
- Shorts, cropped trousers
- Sportswear
- Revealing clothing
- Trainers, flip flops, canvas shoes or leisure shoes/pumps
- Tattoos should not be visible
- Facial piercings other than a suitable nose piercing is not acceptable
- Blouses/shirts that expose the midriff or are low fronted (females)

If a student arrives at school wearing incorrect uniform they may be given the option of borrowing correct uniform from the Sixth Form 'wardrobe' or going home to change. Please refer any ongoing uniform issues to the 6th form team so it may be dealt with accordingly.
